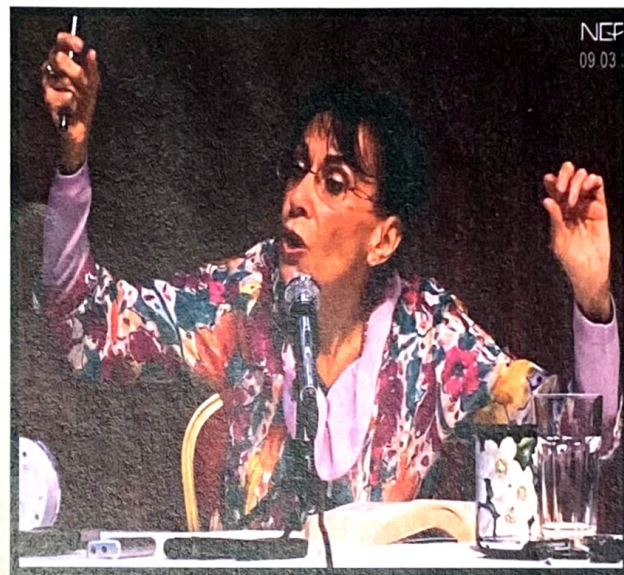
Exploring Current Trends in Islamic Feminism: Female Leadership, Authority, and Spirituality

Is Islamic Feminism an oxymoron? In her presentation Dr. Feyza Burak-Adli will discuss the emerging field of global Islamic feminism and its recent iterations in Turkey. Drawing on her long-term ethnographic fieldwork among the Turkish Rifai Sufi Order led by an unveiled female leader, Cemalnur Sargut, Dr. Burak-Adli will investigate the implications of female religious authority in the production, dissemination, and practice of gender-progressive Islam.
