**Administrative History**

In 1909, St. Ignatius College became the College of Arts and Sciences of Loyola University. The first person to hold the title Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences was Rev. Joseph Reiner, S.J., from 1923 to 1931.

Rev. Walter P. Krolikowski, S.J., was the College of Arts and Sciences seventh dean, from 1963-1970.

**Scope and Content**

Walter P. Krolikowski's dean records consist of 1.25 linear feet spanning from 1963-1970. The records include correspondence, drafts of talks, newspaper articles, program proposals, and event programs. The collection is organized by subject, with series arranged chronologically or alphabetically. Subjects include the College of Arts and Sciences, Maywood Building, and the Department of Fine and Performing Arts.

This series contains Rev. Krolikowski's correspondence during his tenure as dean of the College of Arts and Sciences. Folders are arranged chronologically.
