Administrative Code 25.100:

All professional education and content-area coursework that forms part of an application for licensure, endorsement, or approval that is received on or after October 17, 2017, must have passed with a grade no lower than "C-" or equivalent in order to be counted towards fulfillment of the applicable requirements.

However, Loyola University Chicago's School of Education requires a higher standard for acceptable grades for credit. Candidates must earn a grade of "C" or better to earn credit for a course.
