Submission Details

- Submissions should be previously unpublished, original work.
- All articles should be between 15-60 pages double spaced and contain footnote citations that conform to *The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation*.
- Submissions from current law students will not be accepted.
- Submissions will be reviewed and accepted on a rolling basis for Volume 43 issues.
