SAFETY

- Refine Loyola's active shooter policies to ensure student safety and raise student awareness on active shooter policies
- Co-host education workshops about Title IX policies with the new Office for Equity and Compliance
- Increase frequency of notifications and expand range of the crime alert system
- Increase the number of blue light emergency poles on Water Tower Campus

WELLNESS

- Advocate for more partnerships between community health centers and the Wellness Center
- Create awareness of Wellness Center services (including but not limited to mental health resources)
- Support the Students for Reproductive Justice in their efforts to advocate for free menstruation products to be available in all campus restrooms

SUSTAINABILITY

- Advocate for renewable energy
- Advocate for a sustainable investment portfolio
- Work to implement a "Sustainable Living at Loyola" learning module created for first-year students
- Advocate for faculty to not require students to print out any paper materials for their classes
- Communicate to administration the importance of sustainable practices on Loyola-owned properties

FINANCIAL ACCESSIBILITY

- Advocate for more scholarships and financial assistance with tuition including but not limited to the All Students Prosper If Resources Exist (ASPIRE) Grant
- Build a relationship with the Advancement Division and the Office of Alumni Relations

INCLUSION

- Improve processes of the allocation of funds through the Allocations Committee
- Advocate for more space and resources for identity-based groups including but not limited to a Multicultural Center and more programs
- Create a campaign encouraging students to sign up for classes with a diversity component

ACCESSIBILITY

- Strengthen relationship with Student Accessibility Center to improve and increase resources

CAMPUS ENGAGEMENT

- Continue to work on Public Engagement and Voter Registration
- Advocate for administration to connect and engage with students in unique ways
- Increase SGLC presence and visibility on campus
- Improve SGLC retention and recruitment efforts
- Continue to build a relationship between Arrupe and the undergraduate students of the broader Loyola campus
